If a session is full, you will be contacted for an alternate selection or arrangements will be made to return your payment. Programs with insufficient enrollment will be canceled one week prior to the scheduled start date. All classes are staffed by Lux staff members and assisted by volunteers. There is a maximum of 15 participants and a minimum of 10 participants per session. Each session takes place at the Lux campus in the Lux Classroom, the Artist Pavilion and the exterior grounds.

Each participant will have the opportunity to participate in the Summer Camp Art Show in the Artist Pavilion on Thursday, August 12 from 5-7pm. This is a one-time viewing for the participants' families and friends.
